Excerpt from Hampshire Allegations for Marriage Licences, Vol. 1: Granted by the Bishop of Winchester, 1689 to 1837 Abstracts of the Marriage Allegations from 24th January, 1689, to 12th February, 1693, with one of 23rd June, 1694, are contained in a small quarto Register; these appear to be only of those Marriage Licences applied for at Winchester, the Surrogates being Isaac Jones, S. Wallace, George Bramston, D. Lee, Jos. Spence, and R. Bowen. No bonds or affidavits now exist for an earlier period or the years 1695-1700 inclusive, after which time there is a bundle varying in size for each succeeding year with the exception of 1712. Apparently many Surrogates often failed in their duty of sending the Bonds and Allegations to the Registrar, and this for many years running. It appears to have been the custom formerly for blank licences to have been sent to the Surrogates when their previous stock was exhausted. The parish Church or Churches, in which the ceremony was authorised to be held, were not always given, and a new form of...
