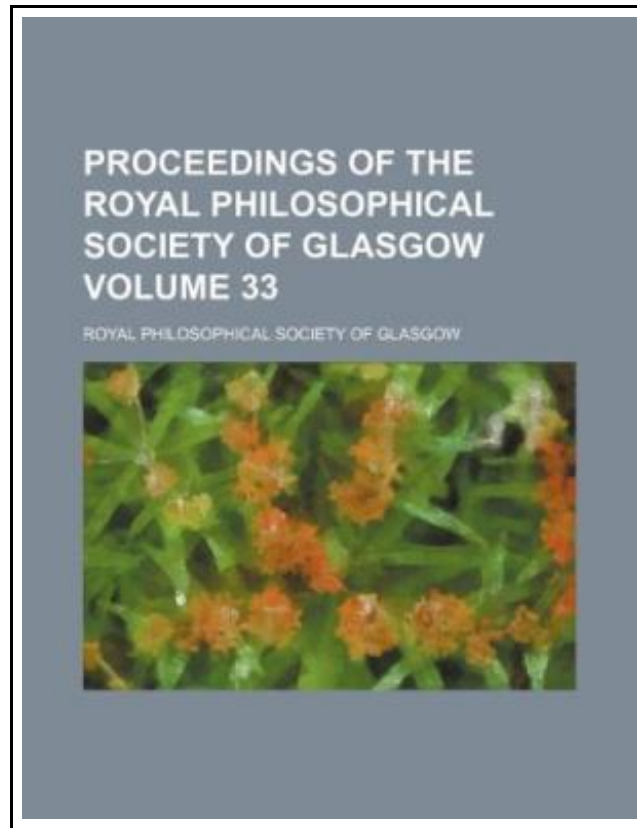

None of the authorities (except perhaps Draudius), gives a full list of their respective works if they were believed to be different, or collectively if they were believed to be identical. It is also worth remarking that they are neither of them mentioned by writers on rare books. Either their works were so rare that they were not known at all, or else they were not considered of sufficient importance to be noticed. When, therefore I identified these writers, 27 I followed what I thought were sound authorities, and omitted to subject them to the scrutiny which the foregoing comparison proves plainly was necessary.
