He was elected member for the County of York in 1806, and High Sheriff of Yorkshire in 1823. But his political activities did not prevent him from taking a keen interest in the Fine Arts. He became one of Turner's early patrons and friends. From about 1810 till Mr. Fawkes's death in 1825, Turner paid frequent visits to Farnley Hall, and made it a sort of headquarters from which his sketching tours in Yorkshire were conducted. Mr. Fawkes not only made Turner an ever welcome guest both at Farnley and at his house...
