Again, while in true zuckerguss condition the exudation is enormous and the adhesions are trifling, in the tubercular form adhesion is more extensive and exudation is relatively slight. In fact the peritoneal cavity may be completely obliterated so that ascites may be absent or at most there may be a few small pockets of exudation between the coils of the intestine. The membrane produced is never smooth and glistening but always covered with fibrin and shaggy adhesions. The liver and spleen are generally large. Tubercular lesions of the various...
